




His Eminence, Archbishop Valerian Trifa

Archbishop of Detroit and The Romanian Orthodox Episcopate of America Consecrated: April 27, 1952

He was the ruling bishop of the Romanian Orthodox Episcopate of America from 1957 until 1984. His tenure as bishop was marred by allegations of association with the fascist-leaning Iron Guard during his youth in Romania. As a result of the allegations he retired as ruling bishop and entered into voluntary exile to Portugal, where he died.

Other small necessity items were donated by many other people.

However, in 1914 the cost of constructing the church was \$ 4,430.45

The two lots were at a cost of \$ 650 and the fence was \$ 275. The painting and the 2 (two) crosses of the church were \$ 149.50. The first vestments for the Priest were \$ 96.08.

In 1913 there were approximately 170 members and their families.

The Society "Augustina" gave \$ 100 donation in 1913 and was instrumental in the founding of our church.

In 2013 a new Holy Altar Table was donated by Elena Lozne IMO her son Robert Neculai and her mother Anica.

The romantic customs with their music, dancing and other homeland traditions were maintained and preserved by the formation of a benevolent society in the growing Romanian population of the Rice Street area.

It was because their strong Faith that their thoughts were constantly focused on building a church of their own in St. Paul.



On May 18, 1913 at a meeting of the "AUGUSTINA" Society (which was a benefit society for Romanians started in 1910) it was voted that a parish church be instituted with the name "Biserica Greco-Orientală Ortodoxă Română Sfânta Maria".

A week later, on May 25, 1913 the church members met for the first time and elected the following officers:


