R ARBATUL ȘI FEMEIA ÎN CĂSĂTORIE

Apostolul Pavel nu face nici un compromis atunci cand este vorba de egalitatea fireasca a barbatului cu femeia in cadrul casatoriei. Iubirea este reciproca: "Barbatul sa-i dea femeii iubirea datorata, asemenea si femeia barbatului" (I Corinteni 7, 3).

Insa in Efeseni cap. 5, lucrurile par sa mearga in alta directie: femeia trebuie sa se supuna barbatului (vers. 22), iar barbatul in schimbul supunerii sotiei, trebuie sa-si iubeasca femeia (vers. 25). Si apostolul Pavel justifica acest fel de relatie cu relatia Hristos-Biserica. Este oare aici una din concesiile pe care le face apostolul Pavel culturii vremii sale, dar pe care o accepta teologic prin legatura Hristos-Biserica? La prima vedere, asa pare sa fie cazul.

Trebuie mai intai observat ca apostolul Pavel foloseste in majoritatea cazurilor, in textele de care ne ocupam, un limbaj inclusiv.

Legatura barbat-femeia in casatorie. Cand vorbeste de barbat este subinteles ca se refera si la pozitia similara a femeii si invers. Caci intreaga argumentare se incheie cu sublinierea idealului casatoriei. Mai intai, barbatul si femeia sunt madulare ale trupului lui Hristos (vers. 29), deci subliniaza valoarea sacramentala a casatoriei, unde nu poate fi inegalitate. Dar chiar daca presupunem ca fiecare madular indeplineste, in cadrul casatoriei, functii deosebite, dupa darul lui Dumnezeu, idee de altfel scumpa lui Pavel, totusi casatoria creeaza "un trup". Geneza 2, 24.

THE REASON FOR LOVE

Some love because they are loved; others love because they have been honored. Still others show love because the person was useful to them in some worldly way and others for similar reasons.

It is hard to find people

who love their neighbors sincerely and for Christ's sake as they ought to love. For most are bound together by worldly affairs. St. Paul loved not this way, but for Christ's sake. Therefore, even when he wasn't loved in the way that he loved, he didn't stop loving them because he had planted the strong root of his affections. (page 2)

In our present state almost anything produces friendship... but love for Christ's sake is firm. It can't be broken or conquered. Nothing can tear it apart: not lies, dangers, death or anything like this. Although those who truly love us suffer ten thousand things, they dig deep and will never stop loving us. Those who love to be loved will end their love when encounter anything painful. But those who are bound by it will never stop.

"And the Lord make you to increase and abound in love one toward another, and toward all men, even as we do toward you" (1 Thessalonians 3:12)

St Innocent the Enlightener of the Aleuts and Apostle to the Americas – Oct. 6

Saint Innocent (Veniaminov), Metropolitan of Moscow and Kolomensk (August 26. 1797—March 31, 1879), was glorified by the Russian Orthodox Church on October 6, 1977. He was born in the village of Anginsk in the Irkutsk diocese. The Apostle of America and Siberia proclaimed the Gospel "even to the ends of the earth": in the Aleutian islands (from 1823), in the six dialects of the local tribes on the island of Sitka (from 1834). among the Kolosh (Tlingit); in the remotest settlements of the extensive Kamchatka diocese (from 1853); among the Koryak, Chukchei, Tungus in the Yakutsk region (from 1853) and North America (in 1857); in the Amur and the Usuriisk region (from 1860).

"For I was hungry and you gave me something to eat, I was thirsty and you gave me something to drink ... "The King will reply, 'Truly I tell you, whatever you did for one of the least of these brothers and sisters of mine, you did for Me." (Matthew 25, 40)

In continuare apostolul Pavel distruge, cu acelasi argument al trupului unic al căsătoriei, ideea dominanta a culturii vremii - bărbatul este stăpân al femeii: "Femeia nu este stapana pe trupul sau, ci barbatul; asemenea nici barbatul nu este stapan pe trupul sau, ci femeia" (I Corinteni 7, 14).

Legatura fizica a barbatului cu femeia lui este absolut imperativa, si aici apostolul Pavel nu face nici o concesie, desi o prezinta ca pe un sfat al lui: "Sa nu va lipsiti unul de altul decat cu buna invoiala pentru un timp, ca sa va indeletniciti cu postul si cu rugaciunea, si iarasi sa fiti impreuna, ca sa nu va ispiteasca satana din pricina neinfranarii voastre" (I Corinteni 7, 5).

Apostolul Pavel spune clar in Galateni 3, 23: "nu este parte barbateasca si parte femeiasca pentru ca voi toti una sunteti in Hristos Iisus". Apostolul Pavel vorbeste aici de egalitatea sacramentala: ,Cati in Hristos v-ati botezat, in Hristos v-ati imbracat" (Galateni 3, 27

Daca iubirea este reciproca, iubirea ca sentiment izvorat din Dumnezeu, caci Dumnezeu este iubire (I Ioan 4, 8), atunci totul in relatia barbat - femeie este bazat pe principiul reciprocitatii, caci iubirea include supunere, slujire, autoritate, putere. Femeia este stapana pe trupul barbatului, dar si barbatul este stapan pe trupul femeii (I Corinteni 7, 4).

"All your children shall be disciples of the Lord and they will enjoy a great happiness" (Isaiah 54, 13)

To any family, children are God's gift. They are the expression of God's blessing and an immense mystery that reverberate the power of His love for us. In His hands this divine energy guides us to eternal happiness.

In this light love seems to be God's method of guiding and shaping our characters regardless of age or role in life. For this, I remind all parents to start bringing their children to God's house and enable them to grow here in the Lord. Try to avoid the false pleasure of "SLEEPING IN ON SUNDAY" for it leads to a disaster.

Without your faith, commitment to the Lord and firm spiritual direction, our children become disoriented and they will cave into the world's pressures. As opposed to this, the beauty of Christian *true love* is that it leads to God.


We are the "new Israel" and reassure us that if we bring the children to be disciples, not only will their happiness be great, but they will be blessed. (conf. Is. 54,13)

HURCH HISTORY 1913-2024

The first Romanian immigrants setting in the Saint Paul area around the year 1910 found themselves in a land with strange customs and new life styles, with no friends except their fellow immigrants, struggling to learn the ways of this new country.

The dynamic growth of a newly industrialized and democratic United States was a vast change from the rural village life of Banat and Transylvania dominated by the Imperial rule of the faltering Austro-Hungarian Empire. These Romanians brought to this country very little of monetary value. However, they did bring with them a steadfast religious faith, replete with beautiful services and traditions. This faith was complemented by the rich ethnic background of the immigrants.

The Romanian customs with their music, dancing and other homeland traditions were maintained and preserved by the by the formation of a benevolent society in the growing Romanian population of the Rice Street area. It was because their strong Faith that their thoughts were constantly focused on building a church of their own in St. Paul and established the St. Mary's parish on May 18, 1913.

A week later, on May 25, 1913 the church members met for the first time and elected the following officers: President: A. Papiu Secretary: J. Farca; Financial secretary: G. Capeti; Treasurer: P. Imbrone, 1st Cantor: J. Sarafolean, 2nd Cantor: M. Ionescu; Members: Cincu Crăciun, George Cristea, Ion Miculescu, Stefan Raica, Ioan Orpria, Simion Gradia, Nicolae Pescari, Vasile Gania.

The newly formed committee bought On November 9, 1913 the land on which the church was to be build. **June 14, 1914** the cornerstone was laid and in October 15, the same year the Romanians celebrated the blessing of their new church together with Rev. Fr. JOHN PODEA from Youngstown, Ohio... more online
